Upcoming Changes to Alberta COVID-19 Restrictions on February 8th

On Friday January 29, Premier Jason Kenney announced easing of some COVID-19 restrictions to take effect on February 8th. Some of the restrictions being eased include in-person service at restaurants and one on one training for indoor fitness being permitted. 
