Chamber Crime Report-August Statistics

- 240 liaison visits.
- 53 Foot patrols.
- 7 Interactions with Intoxicated persons which includes 6 persons being asked by Watchdog to exit businesses and willing doing so.
- 7 insecurities (after hours) including 2 Campers left insecure, 2 Compound gates left open/unlocked, a transport trailer containing goods left open and 2 bay doors left open.
- 3 requests for assistance including first aid rendered to a skateboarder with cuts due to a fall, a battery disconnect for the owner of a vehicle with the alarm sounding, awaiting roadside assistance (ownership confirmed), a BOLO by the RCMP, and several requests for extra patrols. This does not include calls for assistance during nonoperational hours. A liaison visit was conducted for these requests regardless.

4 significant activities:

- Patrol happened upon a B&E in progress in which the suspect was observed departing the scene which involved property damage and the attempted theft of merchandise. RCMP contacted and the suspect was subsequently apprehended.
- Patrol happened upon a B&E in progress which the suspect was observed inside a camper, which involved property damage and the attempted theft of merchandise. RCMP contacted, Dash Cam video captured and surrendered to RCMP.
- Patrol observed a hit and run accident in the parking lot of a local business. The owner of the struck vehicle was informed and the RCMP were contacted.
- Patrol heard what appeared to be gun shots while on patrol in the vicinity of 54th Ave and 54th St. RCMP contacted.

By frequently testing employees, businesses can stop outbreaks before they happen, keeping employees and customers safe.

Next Steps:

After approval, you will receive further instruction to pick-up your kit at the Chamber office during business hours.

Your business/organization will be required to set up an official COVID-19 screening program and testing protocol for all employees partaking in rapid testing and training.

Training materials can be found <u>HERE</u> under the Panbio resources section including a <u>Step-by-step rapid antigen screen video</u>.

Weekly reporting will be required in a form that will be supplied.

Please Note:

- *Rapid testing kits are supplied complimentary to all accepted applicants.
- *Weekly reporting is required to be submitted to the Chamber, stating the number of tests performed and the associated results.
- *These tests are designed to reduce the risk of asymptomatic transmission and *should not* be administered to those with any COVID-19 symptoms!
